動詞 — 一般動詞 は良く使うものから思い出そう

一般動詞

一般動詞の中でも**Have** (has,had), **Take** (takes,took)は便利な動詞です。使いこなしましょう。

I **have** sashimi with steamed rice and miso soupe.

I **have** no cash with me. I don't **have** enough money to buy it.

I **have** a nice son who is doing good job at YMAMAYURI.

I **take** a taxi to SUN farm.

Take note. I am giving you nice lessons.

Take a nap a while. I believe you are so tired.

Get (got. gotten) ==> Gonna I gonna go home

I **got** back to my house on 7:30 and **got** my wife cook my favorite meals.

As you might know, she is very cute. So, I **got** enjoyable time with her smile.

Finally around 11 in the night, I **got** a bed.

It was a long day for me.
